Dr. Danilda D. Hufana-Duran is a Senior Agriculturist and Scientist of the Department of Agriculture-Philippine Carabao Center and also an Affiliate Professor III of the Central Luzon State University both located at the Science City of Muñoz, Nueva Ecija, Philippines. She was a PROMETEO of SENESCYT at the Universidad Tecnica de Babahoyo and a Fulbright Fellow of the University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA. She earned her Ph.D. degree in Agricultural Sciences (reproductive biotechnologies) at University of Tsukuba as scholar of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), her Master's degree in Agriculture (Livestock Reproductive Biotechnologies) at University of Miyazaki, Japan as scholar of the Women's Federation for World Peace, Miyazaki Chapter, and her Bachelor' degree in Biology at Central Luzon State University. She is a multi-awarded scientist with many scientific publications in international scientific journals, book chapters, and conference proceedings. She led the Philippine Research Team that demonstrated the international production and transport of water buffalo in vitro produced-vitrified embryos in India that resulted to the births of live riverine (2n=50) in both riverine and swamp buffalo recipients (2n=48) in the Philippines after embryo transfer. She is a past-president of the Fulbright-Philippine Alumni Association and the current president of the JSPS Alumni Association of the Philippines. She is specialized in embryo in vitro production, cryopreservation, ovum pick-up, embryo transfer, estrus synchronization and artificial insemination for the production of genetically superior livestock.
